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#### Introduction to Charles Drew Transition Center

- Post-Secondary vocational center for Moderate and Severely Cognitively Impaired, Visually Impaired, Hearing Impaired, Physically Impaired, Otherwise Health Impaired, and students with Autism. Students earn a certificate of completion
- Roughly 35% of Drew students have severe and/or multiple disabilities and are wheelchair-bound
- Serves students aged 18-26 in a center-based, vocational work skills environment. Goal is to provide students with skill training that transfers into the adult working world, promote independent living, employability skills
- Building features simulated learning environments through a working bank, laundry facilities, clothing store, convenience store, fitness center, post office, a foods program, woodworking and horticulture programs
- Roughly 130 of our 395 students are placed daily within community businesses in Metro Detroit, including: Veterans Hospital, Sinai-Grace Hospital, Henry Ford Hospital, Salvation Army, TJ Maxx, Chili's Restaurants, Burlington Coat Factory, and Mackenzie Elementary/Middle School.

#### **Drew Horticulture Program**

#### The Gardens at Drew

- The Drew Horticulture Program and *The Gardens at Drew* originated in fall of 2012 as a program designed to impart vocational, social and functional independence skills in a horticulture setting while providing access to fresh, local produce to parents and community
- The Drew Horticulture Program and The Gardens at Drew, with a Hoophouse containing 18 growing beds alongside hydroponic and Dutch Bucket Systems, nine indoor hydroponic growing tables, indoor Aeroponic and Aquaponic Systems, 60 outdoor raised bed garden areas Drew Orchards (22 trees of Apple, Peach, Pear variety) provide the setting for Drew students to assist in the growing of fruits, vegetables and flowers for the Farm 2 School program, food pantry donations, Eastern Market ventures, and for our restaurant and retail clients, gaining valuable skills in horticulture and farming.
- The comprehensive, internationally-recognized Drew Horticulture Program is the largest school market garden program in the country!






## Differentiated Instruction in Food Production





## Level of Independent Tasking


















