Enhance your communications career through a paid editorial internship with *The American Gardener*, the official publication of the American Horticultural Society (AHS). This program is ideal for college students in journalism, English, horticulture, or related fields, as well as adults transitioning careers.

Internship Overview

Interns will collaborate with *The American Gardener* staff, gaining hands-on experience in editorial and production processes. Key responsibilities include:

- Researching and writing articles
- Proofreading and fact-checking
- Coordinating authors and photographer submissions

To broaden the horticultural communications experience, interns may assist with photography and social media for the communications department. Opportunities for professional development workshops and field trips to local gardens are also provided.

Internship Details

- Duration: 3 to 4 months
- Pay: \$15 per hour, 40 hours per week
- Application Deadline Priority: Summer 2025 (February 1)
- Interns must arrange their own housing; a resource sheet for local rentals is available upon request.

Application Requirements

- <u>Completed application form</u> (available when applications reopen)
- Resume
- Two writing samples
- Three professional references (include names, phone numbers, and titles/relationships)
